Summary

Under the supervision of the IT Director, establishes and maintains network performance by building net configurations and connections, and troubleshooting network problems for thirty five sites and the head-end. Responsible for designing, developing, implementing, maintaining, and supporting PLS communication networks, including local area networks (LANs), wide area networks (WANs) and security. Will be on-call 24x7 during one week of every five.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Establishes networking environment by designing system configurations, purchasing equipment and maintenance, directing system installations, defining, documenting, and enforcing system standards
- Maximizes network performance by monitoring performance, troubleshooting network problems and outages, scheduling and completing systems software, application software, hardware, and configuration upgrades
- Secures network system by implementing security appliances and tools, establishing and enforcing policies; defining and monitoring access; maintaining, configuring, and monitoring virus protection software, and conducting staff security awareness trainings

Other Job Duties:

- Performs disaster recovery operations and data backups when required
- Monitors network performance and adjusts via packet shaper if needed
- Confers with network users about solving existing system problems
- PCI compliance
- Responsible for phone system in administration building
- Network equipment purchases
- Vendor relations and negotiations
- Backup to Systems Engineer
- Responsible for all hardware and software inventory
- Maintenance renewals for all network and systems application and hardware
- Gather information for IT Director for yearly budget
- On-call 24x7 IT technician (on rotating basis)
